



Pumpkin Patch 2016



Welcome to our Community & Family Fun! 2100 Ruffin Mill Road, South Chesterfield, I-95 exit 58 526-4000

Jump on the **FREE Wagon Ride** pulled by the Farm Tractor & ride around our field.

(Last wagon pulls out from the barn 30 minutes before closing.)

Early Birds start September 24/25, Saturday/Sunday, 10am-4pm (harvest decorations include straw bales, cornstalks, gourds, various varieties of unusual pumpkins (.79 lb), hayride to PYO jack o’lantern variety orange pumpkins (.59 lb.)

Open for the Season! October 1- 30th (full activities begin on weekend, as weather permits)

Wednesday, Thursday & Fridays 2-6. *Closed Mon & Tues for clean-up, maintenance of equipment & restocking.*

Hayride to pick your own pumpkins. Feed **Goats** (\$1), **Bounce** in the Castle (\$2), **Face Paint** cheek design (\$1), **Toddler Inflatable Animal Kingdom** (\$3). **Straw maze** is FREE weekday afternoons.

Saturday 9-5 & Sunday 10-4.

All of above activities, **plus:** Ride the **Barrel Train** (\$3). Scoot down **Giant Slide** (\$3), **Punkin Mouth Bag Toss** (\$2), **Pumpkin Bowling** (\$1). **Horse & Pony Rides** (\$8) (Horses have shorter day, only weekends, 11am-4pm for the health of our horses.) Horses are led by experienced handlers & children must be at least age 4 to ride pony and minimum of age 6 to ride horse, for the safety of the children. Parents cannot assist during the ride.

Admission, parking and hayride are FREE. You may select individual activities for children & receive tokens or purchase a **“Pumpkin Fun Card” \$20** (value \$26)

Concessions available on weekends, 11 am – 3:30pm, backwoods at *The Screen Porch*, serving Hamburgers, Hot dogs, BBQ sandwiches, Nachos, Pickle on a Stick, Warm Soft Pretzels, Kettle Corn & cold drinks.

Families wishing to **celebrate a child’s birthday in our picnic area** during October weekends must register at office and leave a copy of driver license, paying \$10 fee for each picnic table, reserved in advance. Guests must ride wagon back to the site.



Educational Field Trips

Oct 5 & 6 (*early bird* \$6/\$7); Oct 11, 12, 13, 14, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 24, 25, 26.

Weekdays only (by advance reservation) for groups, tours begin at 9:15 am up to final arrival time 11am for groups of 10+. Time on site is approximately 1 to 1 ½ hours, as decided by school group leader. Picnic tables available if students bring bag lunch. (Bring water bottles rather than soda or sugary fruit drinks which attract bees).

\$50 deposit reserves requested time/date; **\$7 per every person & wristbands provided in advance.** **\$8 for parent walk-up.** SOL adapted program (“Seed to Seed”) for kindergarten & first grade levels with added discussion of pollination, repurposing & recycling in our **Pollination Tunnel** and visiting farm animals. A wagon ride to the field allows participants to select a free small pumpkin as a gift & remembrance of their adventure.
